Professor Steve Holt qualified from the Middlesex and University College Hospitals, London, UK. He did much of his renal training at The Royal Free Hospital, London, UK including winning a prestigious Medical Research Council training fellowship to support a PhD looking into oxidative injury in renal dysfunction. He was appointed Consultant Nephrologist and Honorary Senior Lecturer at Brighton and Sussex University Hospitals, Brighton, Sussex, UK from 2001-2010.

Here he also became Clinical Director of the Clinical Investigation and Research Unit and responsible for increasing and amalgamating the clinical, translational and basic science research for the University, Hospital and Medical School. In 2010 he joined Eastern Health and Monash University in Melbourne Australia, and was lead clinician for the Home Therapies and Research within the Renal Unit. In 2013 he was appointed Director of Nephrology at The Royal Melbourne Hospital, Parkville, Victoria. He has numerous peer review publications, a number of book chapters and co-authored the UK Renal Association Guidelines on Cardiovascular disease in CKD 2010.
